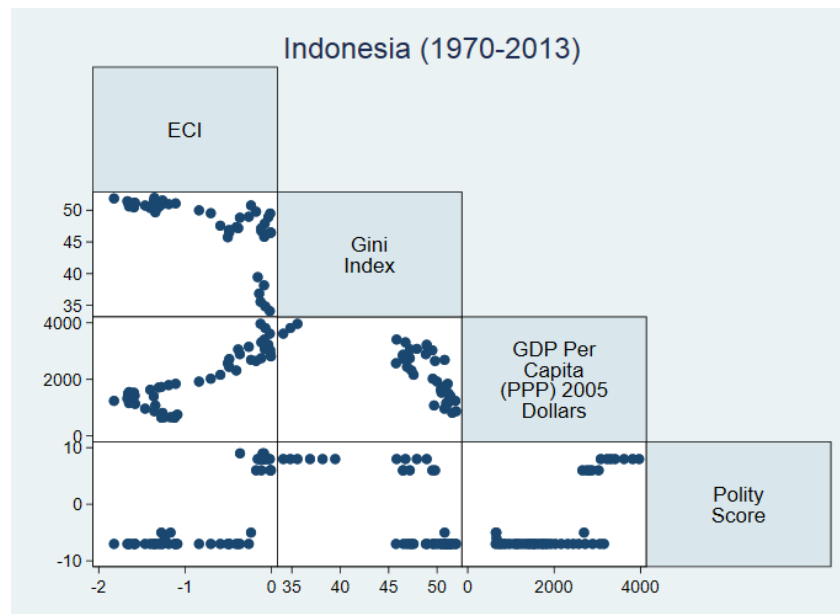


Figure 7- Correlative Matrix of Indonesia (1970-2013)

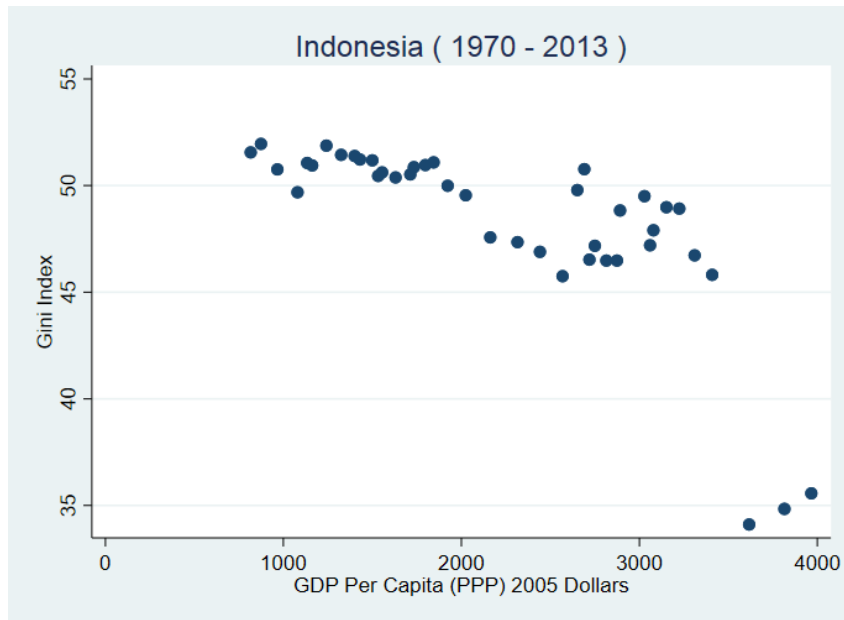


Figure 8- GDP Per Capita and Gini coefficient of Indonesia Time Series (1970-2013)

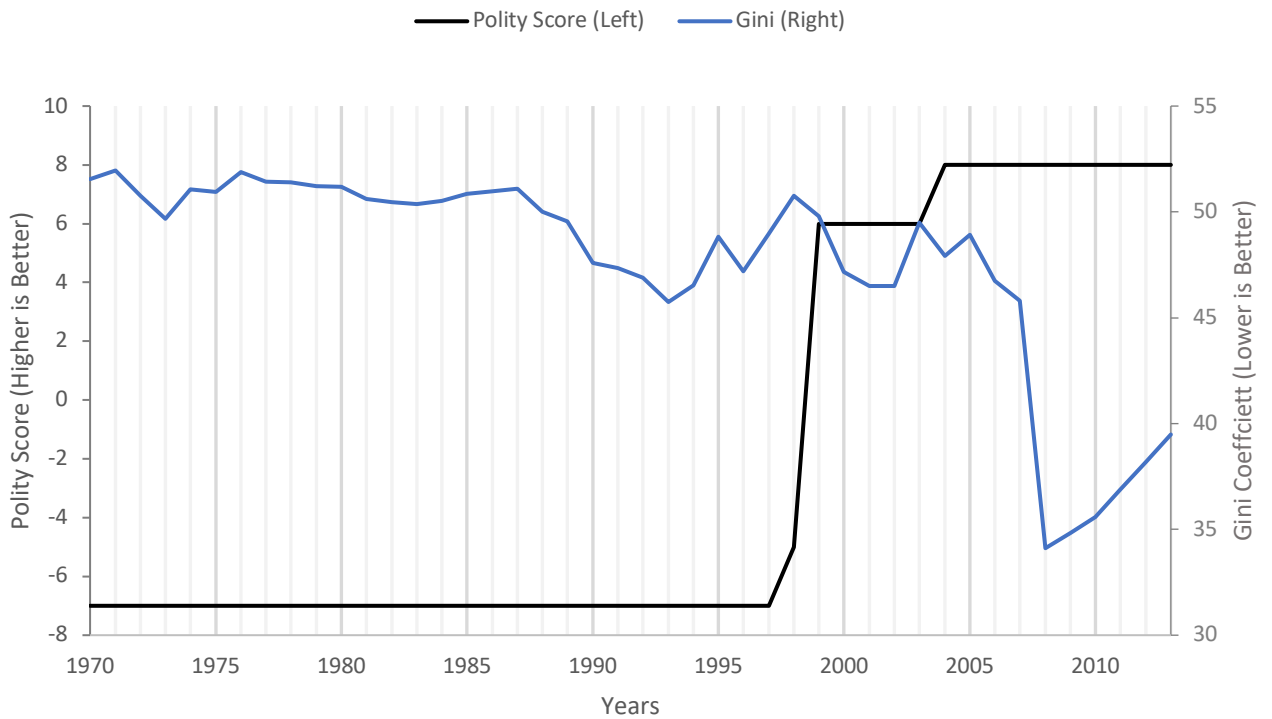
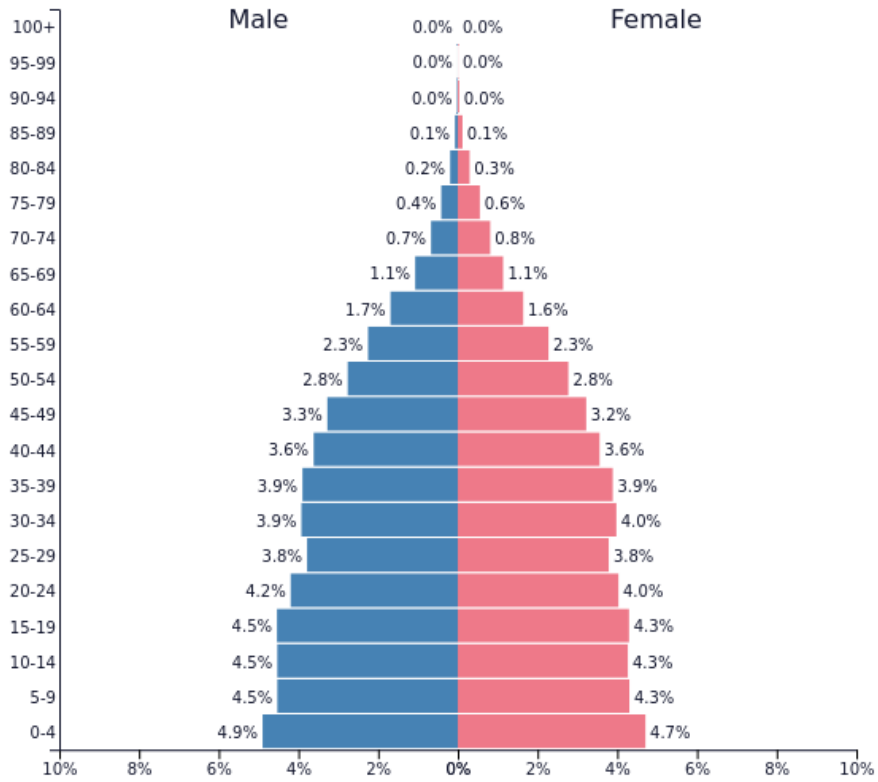


Figure 9- Polity IV Score and Income Inequality in Indonesia (1970-2013)

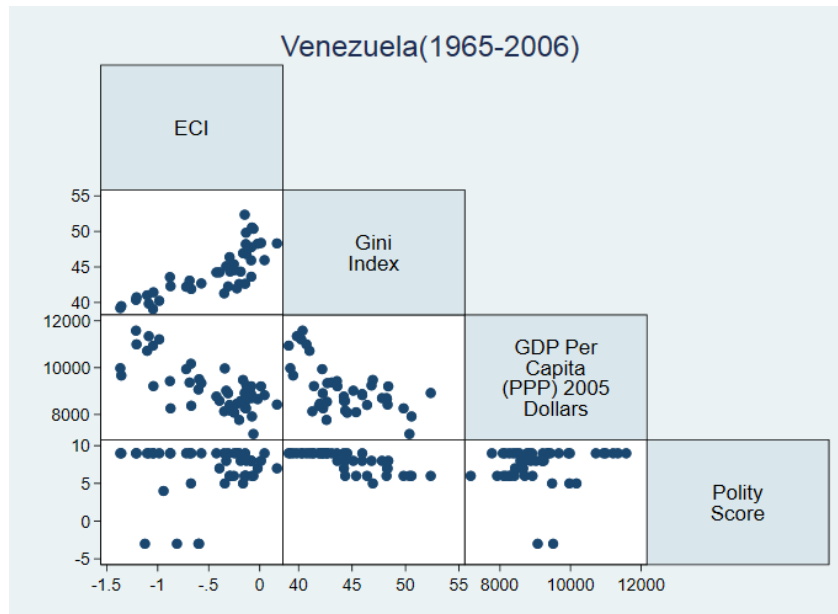


Figure 10- Correlative Matrix of Venezuela (1965-2006)

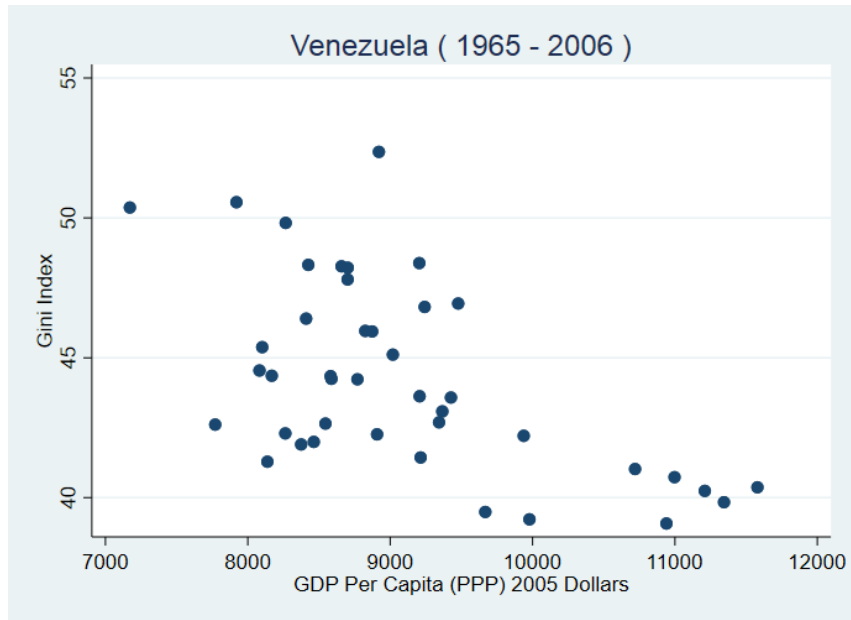


Figure 11- GDP Per Capita and Gini coefficient Time Series (1965-2006)

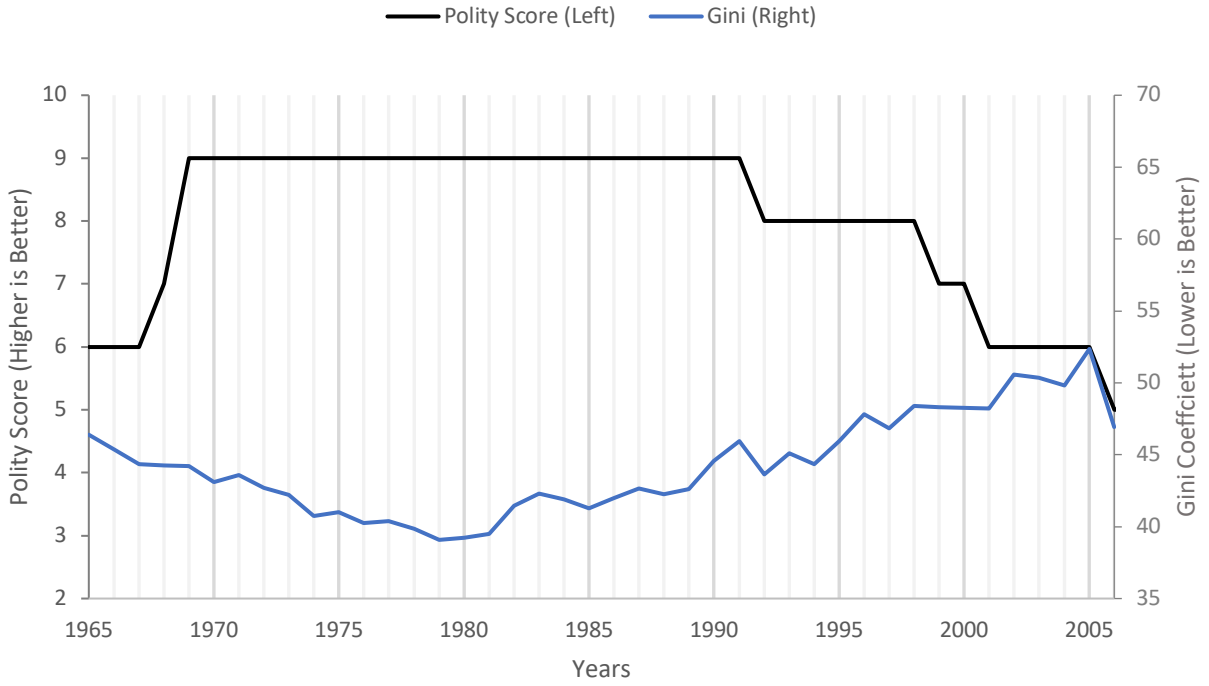


Figure 12- Polity IV Score and Income Inequality in Venezuela (1965-2006)
